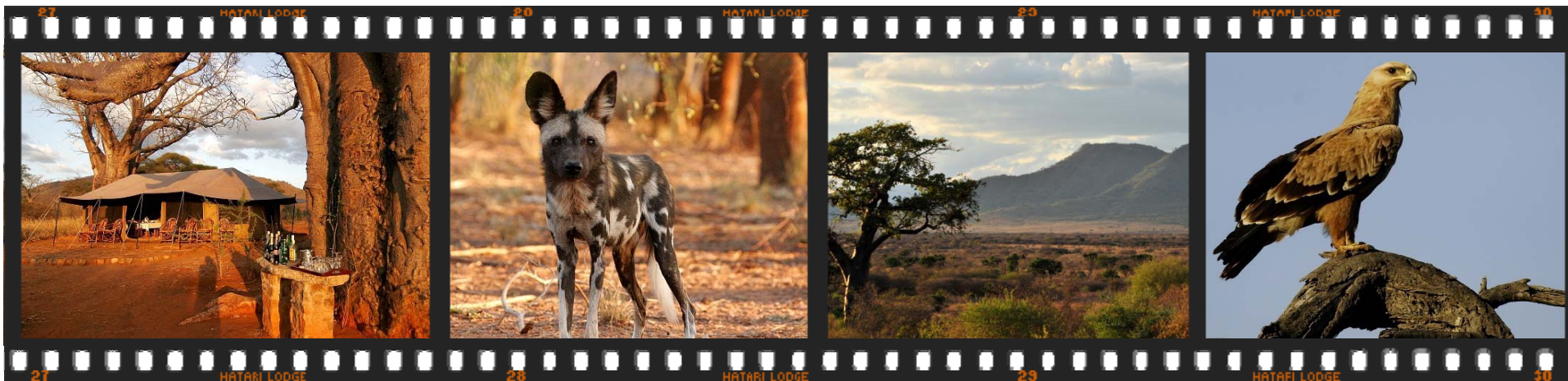

Day 8: Flight to Pangani, one of East Africa's most beautiful beaches.
Overnight at the beach lodge, full board

Day 3: Drive to Mkomazi National Park arriving in untouched wilderness.
Overnight in the camp, full board

Days 9-10: Choose from a variety of excursions or simply relax!
Overnight at the beach lodge, full board

Day 4: All day game drive. watch out for rhinos and other animals at the waterhole!
Overnight in the camp, full board

Day 11: Flight to Stone Town, Zanzibar.
Overnight with bed and breakfast at a small romantic hotel

Day 5: Drive to Hatari's "private Serengeti" and our own Shu'mata Camp in the
Maasai plains. *Overnight at Shu'mata Camp, full board*
